A Campground Rules and Regulations

Welcome to Upper Shunda Creek Campground! Please familiarize yourself with the following campground rules and regulations to ensure a safe and comfortable visit. Guests unable to comply will be asked to leave without refund.



Please come to the office immediately upon arrival before setting up to register and pay any remaining camping fees. This includes those who have prepaid.



Please drive with caution and watch for children playing and bicycles. The maximum speed limit is 15 km/hr.



Dogs are welcome, but must be kept on a leash and under the control at all times. **Dogs are not allowed to roam free, and you must pick up after your dog.** This is to ensure the safety of campers, wildlife, other pets as well as your own dog.



Consumption of alcohol is restricted to registered campsites only. No disorderly behaviour will be tolerated. We kindly ask that all campers conduct themselves in a manner that is respectful and considerate of other campers. **No recreational use of cannabis is permitted on the campground.**



Please confine campfires to the provided fire pits. **Do not leave fire unattended.** No outside wood is to be burned without consulting with campground operators as permits may be necessary. No wood gathering is permitted within the campground. Firewood is available for purchase at the campground store. See posted "Wood Policy" for clarification.



Registered campers with Off Highway Vehicles (OHV's) are welcome. and permitted to off-load and ride OHV from their campsite. Please see the posted "ATV" rules regarding the operation of your OHV on the campground.



Quiet hours are from 11:00 PM to 7:00 AM. Generator hours are from 8:00 AM to 11:00 PM. <u>Check out time is 1:00 PM sharp. Check-in time</u> anytime after 2:00 PM.



Plastic tablecloths are required on campground tables, you may bring your own for use. Plastic tablecloths **are** available for purchase from the Campground store.
